BML ATOMIC BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENT

The BML Atomic Business Requirements Document is a robust suite of reports designed to support and enable IT initiatives, most notably the automatic generation of accurate, systematic and consistent business requirements from BML models. Reports include the following:

Atomic Requirements Object Glossary	Assists in bringing together associates of different backgrounds, specialties and experience, by providing a common understanding of terminology used in the defined business process. Atomic Requirements Object vs. Model Affinity Matrix	Displays a list of objects and shows where they appear in the BML How models that have been included in the report.
Atomic Requirements Project Information	Provides project information.
Atomic Requirements	Generates textual and visual based atomic requirements for each of the Activities included in the BML HOW models.
Atomic Business Requirements Document (BRD)	Auto-generates a business requirements document based on a generic requirements template that includes a set of pre-defined report sections and a report structure which can be formatted by the user.

The BML Atomic Business Requirements Document may be output as a Microsoft Word document (.docx), Microsoft Word 97-2003 document (.doc), Web Page (.html), or Web Page Archive (.mht).

Title Page

- Includes the title of the document, date generated, and logo

Table of Contents

- Lists the contents of the documents with linked page numbers

Project Information

- **Project Name**
 - Specifies the name of the project
- **Project Description**
 - Provides the description of the project
- **Project Sponsors**
 - Lists contact information for the project sponsors
- **Project Authors**
 - Lists contact information for the project authors
- **Project Participants**
 - Lists contact information for the project participants

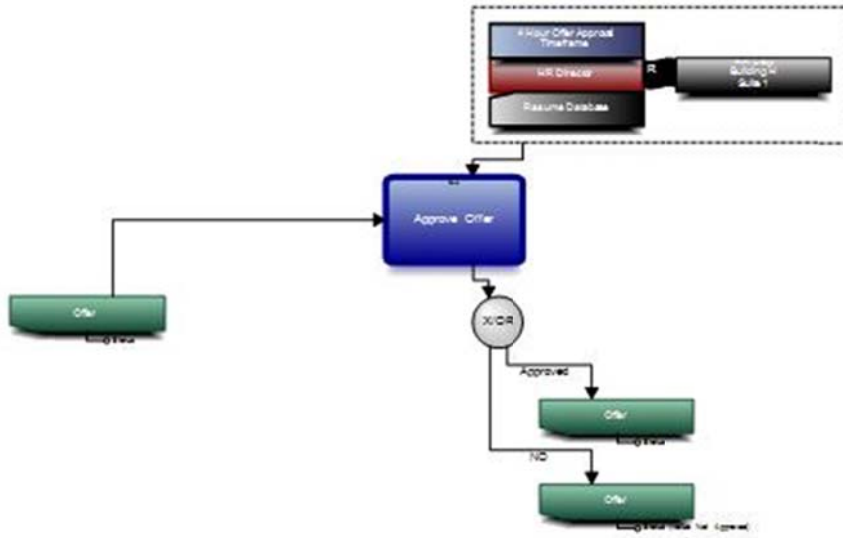
Atomic Requirements

- **Purpose and Scope**
 - Describes the business purpose and scope for the specific business process covered in the ABRD
- **Level of Detail**
 - Includes the level of detailed covered in the ABRD
- **Information Contained in the Document**
 - Lists the BML How models that are included in the ABRD
- **Sample Requirement Atom Graphic**
 - Displays a picture of a sample requirement atom
- **Narrative for Process Flow**
 - **Process Flow Objective**
 - Described the objective for the process flows
 - **Process Flow Graphical Legend**
 - Displays a picture of the legend from the BML How model
 - **Atomic Requirement**
 - **Objective**
 - Described the object for the Atomic Requirement
 - **Requirement Atom Graph**



BML ATOMIC BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS DOCUMENT (ABRD)

- Displays a picture of the Requirement Atom showing the Activity, along with associated inputs and outputs to other dimensions (i.e. WHICH, WHO, WHERE, WHEN).



- **Actors**
 - Provides a list of WHO objects attached to the activity along with RACI information
- **Triggers and Frequency**
 - Provides a list of WHEN objects attached to the activity
- **Location(s) where Activity occurs**
 - Provides a list of WHERE objects attached to the activity
- **Supplemental Information**
 - Lists supplemental information that is attached to the activity via a profile
- **Information Flows**
 - Displays the input and output flows to and from the activity and includes detailed CRU information.

Appendices

- **WHICH Object Glossary**
 - The glossary appendix assists in bringing together associates of different backgrounds, specialties and experience, by providing a common understanding
